Three-in-a-Row on the 100 Chart

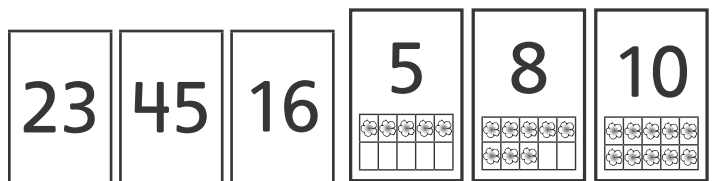
Directions

You need

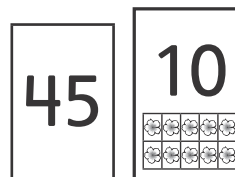
- a set of Number Cards, 1–50 (51–100 are used for the variation)
- a set of Primary Number Cards without the Wild Cards
- transparent counters
- 100 Chart (T15)

Play with a partner. Work together.

1 Pick 3 Number Cards and 3 Primary Number Cards. Turn the cards over so both players can see them.



2 Choose one Number Card and one Primary Number Card and add the numbers together.



3 Find the sum on the 100 Chart and cover it with a counter. You may try different combinations before deciding which number to cover.

4 Set aside the two cards you used. Pick one more card from each deck. There should always be 3 Number Cards and 3 Primary Number Cards.

5 Continue playing until you get three counters in a row.

More Ways to Play

- Use the Wild Cards. A Wild Card can be any number.
- Use Number Cards for 1–90 and play on the entire 100 Chart.
- Each player chooses a counter and tries to get 3 in a row.
