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The Penny Jar Game

Directions

You need

- Deck of Primary Number Cards (without 0 and Wild Cards)
- *The Penny Jar Game* Recording Sheet (G55; 1 per player)

Play with a partner. Work together.

- 1 Turnover a card and record that number under Starting Amount.
- 2 Turn over another card and record that number under Ending Amount.
- 3 Together, decide if you need to add pennies to the jar, or take pennies from the jar, to get from the Starting Amount to the Ending Amount.
- 4 Circle the symbol that shows whether you are adding pennies or taking pennies away (+ / -).
- 5 Together, figure out *how many* pennies to add or take away to get from the Starting Amount to the Ending Amount, and record it on the blank.
- 6 Repeat steps 1–5.
- 7 Play until the Recording Sheet is filled.
